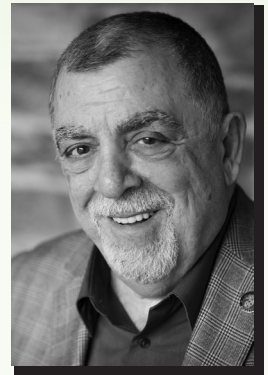
Everything you ever wanted to know about Modern Psychoanalysis

Our next guest, Theodore Laquercia, PhD, LP will address questions from the audience about the theory, practice, training, and history of Modern Psychoanalysis. He is an instructor and training and supervising analyst at CMPS and BGSP. He is past president of BGSP and currently president of the Society of Modern Psychoanalysts. He sits on the CMPS Board of Trustees and is also CMPS Director of Special Projects. He has published papers on a range of topics: the modern analytic treatment of psychosis, Freud's dual-drive theory, the anaclitic countertransference, symbolic communication, and analytic listening, among others.

A current area of interest is the art of psychoanalysis. Dr. Laquercia worked very closely with two major figures in Modern Psychoanalysis, Hyman Spotnitz and Phyllis Meadow, and has been associated with CMPS since its inception in 1971. Dr. Sara Sheftel is moderator for the event.
