Sex in the Consulting Room: *Decoding the Hidden Meanings of Erotic Transference*

The taboo on—as well as the inevitability of—sexual feelings in the treatment room has been an issue in psychoanalysis since its inception, and the challenge of working with these feelings is an integral part of its fabric. As much as understanding how to navigate feelings of erotic transference and countertransference is an essential part of the work, what lies beneath is often more difficult to reach, and frequently holds the key to deeper psychic conflicts. Through readings and case material this workshop will lay the groundwork for exploring the layers of sexualization in the erotic transference to gain insight into what might hide within.
